## Grads Entering Independent Living

In 2009, PHFC has six high school seniors with the potential to earn diplomas and enter the Ray Campbell Independent Living Village. This is a time of celebration since it's rare to have more than one senior on track to graduate.

The Child Welfare League of America has found that only about half of foster care youth complete high school. PHFC has set a goal of seeing at least 60% of eligible youth graduate or earn a GED.

One of the six has already graduated, receiving her diploma in January. Megan then entered the Independent Living Program and began classes at AB-Tech.

But while Megan is the first young person in independent living, she will soon be joined by several others.

Brandy, Logan, Mariah, Meg and Victor are all considering entering the program in June 2009. Some youth will be the first in their family to graduate high school.

"This is a chance at life," said Mariah, a 17-year-old senior at Owen High School. She hopes to enter the program and earn a degree in outdoor education. She has even discussed the possibility of returning to PHFC to work once she has completed her schooling.

And while there are no guarantees that all six will enter the Independent Living Program, PHFC staff is thrilled to see them exploring the possibility and considering options that would not have been open to them in the past.

## Local Charities Help Out

In today's challenging economic times, Presbyterian Home for Children has been blessed to receive the support of several local charities and businesses that have helped to keep programs growing.

Last fall, the Home received a \$2,500 grant from **Target**. In December, the Home was the recipient of a \$5,000 grant from **Bi-Lo Charities** as well as a gift of \$2,500 from the **David Belk**

**Cannon Foundation**. January brought a \$1,000 grant from the **Rotary Club of Asheville**.

"It's so encouraging knowing that businesses, organizations and individuals will reach out and help children even when times are tough," said PHFC President Tom Campbell. "It's reassuring to see folks reaching out not only to us, but to charities everywhere. As times tighten, the need for services like ours inevitably grows."

## Yard Sale May 2

Presbyterian Home will hold its first annual yard sale May 2, 2009, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. Items have been provided by donors from throughout Western North Carolina and include everything from furniture, to dishes, to tools.

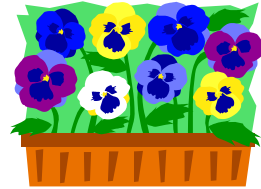
