### Top 10 Projects

1. **Maintain Grounds** - we have 90 acres and one maintenance person—we can always use a hand!
2. **Teachers** – piano, guitar, photography, crafts, etc.; commit 1 hour weekly for 6-week course.
3. **Skilled Craftsmen** – stonemasons to do rockwork.
4. **Tutors** – help children who are behind academically.
5. **Concrete Workers** – to donate and pour concrete.
6. **Gardener/Landscaper** – able to plant a garden or bed or help maintain a portion of landscape.
7. **Computer Repair / IT Specialist** – willing to help with information technology issues.
8. **Woodworker** – make frames, birdhouses and simple items.
9. **Plumber** – help with plumbing projects on an as needed basis.
10. **Carver** - sculpt tree trunks.

# Volunteers Keep Presbyterian Home Under Budget and Looking Good

Presbyterian Home for Children finished the 2006-2007 fiscal year 14% under budget--in part thanks to the hard work of volunteers.

Last year more than 1,500 volunteers donated their time and elbow grease at PHFC, putting in approximately 14,000 hours of work. Volunteers came from as far away as South Dakota and Vermont and as close as Montreat and Warren Wilson Colleges.

There were church groups, youth groups, seniors, preschoolers and everyone in between and they accomplished a great deal of work that PHFC would have had to outsource without their help.

Just a few of the major projects completed recently include:

- ✓ Construction of a playground for youth 12 and under.
- ✓ The renovation of Barkley Building with a bunkhouse upstairs and donations receiving and storage downstairs.

- ✓ Repainting the children's rooms in all the cottages.
- ✓ Repainting and deep cleaning offices in the Smith Building.
- ✓ Clearing brush to make way for the Ray Campbell Independent Living Village.
- ✓ Landscaping including planting apple and cherry trees, azaleas and Rose of Sharon bushes.
- ✓ And then there are all those every day volunteer projects like tutoring the children, collecting needed items to donate, mowing

grass and updating the PHFC website.

Caring groups and individuals have consistently come up with wonderful and creative ways to help out at PHFC. The children, staff and board are deeply grateful and look forward to continuing to build lasting relationship with our wonderful volunteers.
